A neat and tidy standard of dress is required on the course and in the clubhouse at all times. Members or visitors not complying with the dress code may be asked to leave the premises.

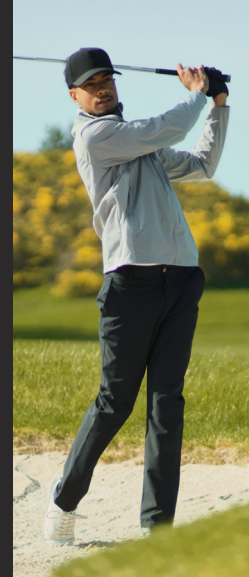


LADIES

- Golf dresses or sleeveless shirts with a collar, or be of a recognisable golf design
- Recognised golf tops designed to be worn outside the waistband are permitted
- Shorts and skorts must be of an appropriate length with socks of any colour or length
- Golf shoes

UNACCEPTABLE CLOTHING ON THE COURSE:

Trainers, denims, track suits, vests, football kit (or other sports kits), cargo shorts, beach wear, non-golf attire tee shirts, headgear to be worn correctly i.e. peaks facing forward.



MEN

- Shirts must have a collar and sleeves, or be of a recognisable golf design, and tucked in at the waist
- Tailored trousers or tailored knee length shorts
- Socks of any colour or length must be worn
- Golf shoes

UNACCEPTABLE CLOTHING IN THE CLUBHOUSE:

Ripped or faded jeans, track suits, vests, football kit (or other sports kits), tee shirts with large branding, cargo shorts, beach wear, sliders, plastic flip-flops, non-formal headgear, wet or dirty clothing.

The above rules also apply to the outside social areas.
